Dear Friends,

Merry Christmas to you!!! God has been showing great miracles to us throughout this year and we'd like to share some with you in this letter! We praise Him for the promise He gave in His Word, "Call to me, and I will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known" (Jeremiah 33:3). This past year has not been an exception. We prayed and God showed us amazing things!



During this year we have been praying for discipleship opportunities. God has blessed us with new friendships and disciples. Instead of usual 3 summer camps, we had 5 this year. Every camp went great. We gave out many Bibles and saw many teens come to know the Lord. After the camps we started several more Bible studies (ages 12-18). We have 6 total now. At the same time, we meet with some people one-on-one to help them mature in Christ. We added another Bible study for the kids (ages 8-11) on Saturdays. We continue witnessing through our ESL classes as well.

God has blessed us with several people who came to know the Lord through our summer camp ministry. These people are involved in Bible study groups now. Some of them expressed a desire to be a part of our youth ministry team where they now faithfully serve on a weekly basis.

PERSONAL NEEDS:

The purchase of a vehicle (a mini-van or an SUV 2006 -2007 make) that will be safe to drive in the winter.
