Dear Friends,

Hi! How are you doing? We pray you're doing well! God has blessed us with two more months of fruitful ministry. In September, our church held two projects. We had a team from Texas come. They worked on rebuilding 3 more cabins at our camp site. So far, God has blessed us with 5 new cabins. For some people it may not be a big deal, but it is definitely a big deal for the kids. It also is a good testimony to the department that gives us a permit to conduct our camps every summer.



Our church together with the Christian Policemen Association received a team of Christian police officers from several states. During their stay here (a week) they were sharing their experience and faith with our local police forces. It is the third time we have done a project like that and I see how God blesses us with new friendships with local officers. Please be praying for their salvation and safety as we continue witnessing to them.

At the end of October, our church partnered with two more local churches and held two seminars at two different locations on "Winning the Purity War" (for singles) and "Purity in Marriage" (for married couples). The speaker was Dr. James Cecy, the author of the book "The Purity War." It was great to see some teens whom we have met at one of our summer camps joining us at the first seminar. We know it was good for them to hear what God thinks about personal purity before Him.



We have seen some great outcomes from our ministry this past summer. Almost every Saturday we have had about 35 to 40 nonbelievers joining us for the youth ministry. Some girls started attending Bible studies. Some guys have been asking me (Serghei) some serious questions on faith, Christianity, and cults. I never expected some of these guys would ever approach me with these kind of questions. I am truly amazed at how God works in their lives. I will continue meeting with these guys and teaching them from the Bible on God's Purpose for their lives. Please keep praying for the teens that come to our weekly youth meetings and bible studies. Pray that they to know God in a personal way through His Son Jesus Christ.
