Dear Friends,

Hi! How are you doing? It has been a while since you have heard from us but we are glad to remind you that we still exist. :) The past 2 months have been filled with many events and meetings which God blessed us with.

1Peter 1:6 reads, "In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been distressed by various trials..." We don't like trials but we have to go through them for various reasons. My (Serghei's) father passed away 2 weeks ago. It was both hard and relieving at the same time. My dad has been sick with lung cancer for the past 10 months. After months of chemo his body just gave up. He spent his last week at home in bed and past away when my sister, her husband and I were there with him. Please keep my sister and her husband in prayer, especially be praying for their salvation.



Since this past summer, God has been bringing a good number of guys to our youth meetings. We average 35-45 teens every Saturday night. We also invited some to join us at our home group that we lead every Wednesday night. We are going through "The Abiding Life" Series where we are learning together how to abide in Christ no matter what the circumstances in life might be. A number of girls has also joined our girls Bible study as well. Some of the teens have started attending the church regularly, and some even brought their parents to church. Two moms have joined the church in August and have been coming almost every Sunday. Please, continue praying for everyone who was touched this summer by the Gospel. Pray that they entrust their lives to Christ.

Last month I got a facebook message from a girl who's been coming to our youth meetings for a long time. She has also come to several youth and English camps. She wanted to talk because she couldn't live the life style she's been living for a long time anymore. As we met and talked, she gave her life to the Lord. Please pray that she grows in the knowledge of Christ and become His servant in the near future.
